

member of the College, a correct copy of the Register containing the names and surnames, in alphabetical order, of all physicians then living and regularly registered, with their residences, titles, degrees and qualifications conferred on them by any authorized institution. Such Register shall be in the form of schedule A, and shall be known under the name of the "Quebec Medical Register".

15. In consideration of his services, the Registrar shall receive the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) annually, to be paid out of the funds of the College. He shall have to perform without demanding any commission or supplementary indemnity all the office work, correspondence, collections, etc., formerly done by the agent, whose position is abolished. Under the President's direction, the Registrar shall see to the enforcement of the provisions of the law concerning the practice of Medicine and Surgery and also of the decisions of the Board of Governors.

CHAPTER III.

Committees of the Board of Governors.

1. The permanent Committees of the Board of Governors are :—

1. The Committee on Credentials, composed of the Officers of the Board, the Ex-President and of a sufficient number of members, to allow all the Medical Faculties to be represented ;

2. The Committee on Examinations, composed of twelve members, named by the President ;
