

REV. JOSEPH W. PRING

THE Rev. J. W. Pring was born at Dunkeswell, Devonshire, England and spent his early boyhood there. In the fall of 1873 he came with his parents to Canada and the family settled in London. He was educated in London, and entered the ministry in 1880, being stationed at Dorchester, with the late Rev. J. L. Kerr as superintendent. He was appointed to Victoria University, Coburg, in 1882, and ordained in 1884. He has held appointments at Attwood, Wellburn, Fordwich, Bluevale, Nile, Port Lambton, Thedford, and Avon, and is now stationed at Fingal. His wife is a daughter of the late William Philp of Maryboro township, and a cousin of Rev. Dr. John Philp at one time pastor of the First Methodist Church in St. Thomas and London.
