**Portsmouth**—An incorporated village adjoining the city on its western boundary, connected with it by the street railway. Here is located the Kingston Penitentiary, a very handsome building, situated at the eastern end of the village, on the river's banks. At the western end is the Kingston Asylum for the Insane; the building is a very fine and handsome structure of cut stone; the grounds are most beautiful and are tastily laid out. Among the other principal buildings are the Warden's residence, a most beautiful structure, surrounded by ornamental grounds well laid out, and the Episcopal and Methodist churches, Town Hall, and a number of private residences. Population, exclusive of the Asylum and Penitentiary, about 900. Assessed value, \$121,000.
