

About fifty were drowned by the sinking of a dilapidated ferry boat while crossing the River Tcheptsa on Ascension Day, June 5th. The boat was proceeding to the town of Glazov, 98 miles from Viatka. A riot en sued among the populace, owing to a lack of police supervision of the ferry.

MEXICO CITY, June 10. Twenty survivors of the Federal garrison, which was unsuccessful in the defence of Zacatecas, struggled into Aqua Scalientes to-day, with further confirmation of the capture of the city by rebel forces a month ago. Reports which the survivors furnished, were telegraphed to the officials of the war department here.

BELGRADE, June 10. The Servian Minister of War to-day declared that war or peace would be decided in two or three days. Servia, he said, must retain all the territory which had been occupied by her troops, and the Powers must per suade Bulgaria to modify the Treaty of Alliance entered into with Servia before the war with Turkey, otherwise war was certain.

BELGRADE, June 10. Railway communication between Servia and Bulgaria has been stopped, and the Servian newspapers assert that the Servian Minister to Sofia is about to quit that capital.
