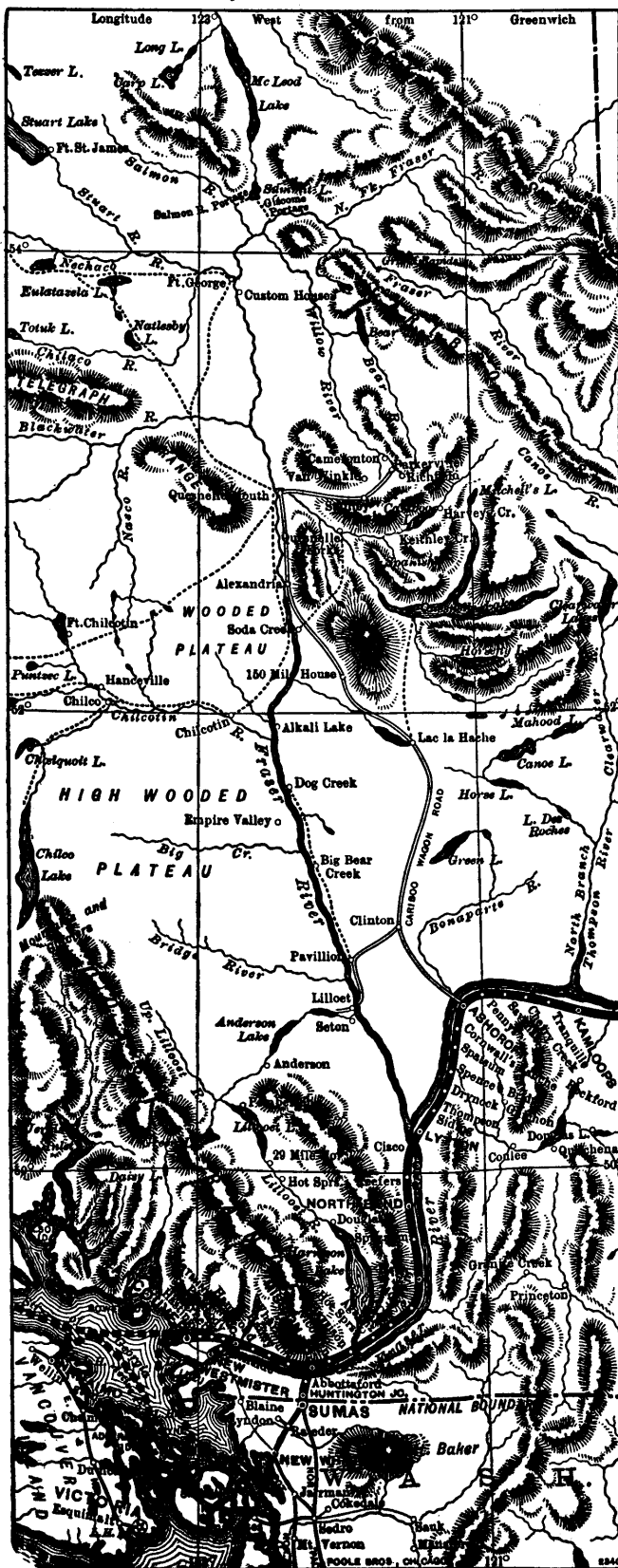


CARIBOO.
