hungry, I have often sat down by the roadside and read my mother's Bible, and it seemed to feed and rest me." "I will give you enough for it to pay your passage." "I cannot sell it sir, indeed I cannot, even if I have to walk to New York."

The kind gentlemen gave him a line to the captain to take the boy free to New York, and when there, to plav: him in the care of a policeman to find his aunt, and also to see that he went to a good school, and to follow hin up to higher schools, and he would pay all his bills for schooling, books, etc. A short time since, at a great Sebbath School convention out West, one of the best addresses was made by that boy (now a man) who loved his Bible so.N.
