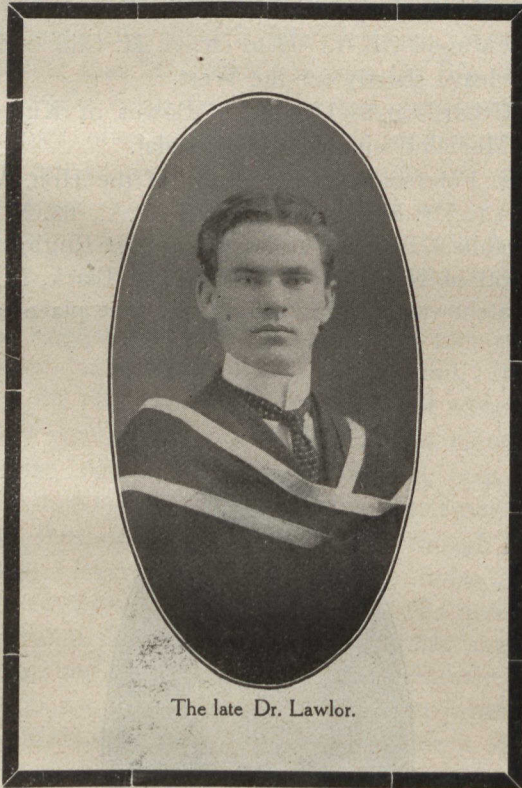


OBITUARIES.

DR. C. A. LAWLOR.

It is with great regret that we record the death of one of our recent graduates, Dr. Charles Augustin Lawlor, of Kingston, who received his degree from Queen's Medical College last spring.
