EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE CONTINUED USE OF THE CHURCHILL RESEARCH RANGE

EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to the Arrangement of April 28, 1972<sup>(1)</sup>, in amendment of the Agreement of July 8, 1969<sup>(2)</sup>, between the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Government of Canada concerning the use of the Churchill Research Range, and to propose on behalf of the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany that the following Arrangement be concluded:

- 1. The Agreement of July 8, 1969, concerning the use of the Churchill Research Range, due to expire on June 30, 1973, in accordance with Article 21 (2), shall be extended until June 30, 1975.
- 2. The present Arrangement shall also apply to Land Berlin, provided that the government of the Federal Republic of Germany does not make a contrary declaration to the Government of Canada within three months of the entry into force of this Arrangement.

If the Government of Canada agrees to the proposals contained in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and your Excellency's Note in reply thereto expressing the agreement of your Government shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments to enter into force on the date in your Note in reply.

Accept, Excellency, the assurance of my highest consideration.
