44. The two countries will encourage contacts between Mexico's Sociedad General de Autores y Escritores [National Writers' Association] and the Canadian Writers' Union.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

45. Each country will study the possibility of translating and publishing works by the other country's writers.

IV. ANTHROPOLOGY AND HISTORY

46. The INAH's Escuela Nacional de Antropología e Historia
[National School of Anthropology and History] has expressed interest in
receiving a specialist from the Royal Ontario Museum to give a field
seminar at Chicontepec, in the state of Veracruz.

The visit would take place in the month of September, at some time during the period of the Programme.

The exact dates, the duration of the visit, and other details will be made known through diplomatic channels.

The Canadian side will convey this interest to the Royal Ontario Museum, and will respond through diplomatic channels.

47. The INAH's Escuela Nacional de Conservación,
Restauración y Museografía Manuel del Castillo Negrete [Manuel del
Castillo Negrete National School of Conservation, Restoration, and
Museography] has expressed the wish to receive Dr Nathan Stolow once
again, to give a three-week course on museology.
