

Carlos Roberto Reina
President of the Republic of Honduras

Born on March 13, 1926, in Comayagua, Carlos Roberto Reina was educated at the National Autonomous University of Honduras, and earned a doctorate in international law at the University of Paris (Sorbonne).

Dr. Reina has lectured in law and served as a judge. He was a diplomat for more than 30 years.

Dr. Reina was Vice-President of the Latin American Parliament during 1971-73, and the Honduran delegate at the Central American Congress in 1971.

In 1980, he was appointed to the International Court of Justice. He subsequently lectured in the faculty of law at the National Autonomous University of Honduras and has been a regular lecturer at foreign universities.

On Jan. 27, 1994, Dr. Reina began a four-year term as President of Honduras.

Dr. Reina is married to Bessie Watson. They have three children.
