The Right Honourable Kobert Gordon Menzies, Prime Minister of Australia, and Mrs. Menzios will arrive in Ottawa on Sunday, June 22 , at $5.30 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. DT for a visit of four days. They will be accompanied by the Secretary, Australian Dopartment of External Affairs, Wr. A.S. Watt; tho Secretary, Department of the Treasury, Dr. Roland VIlson; the Deputy Secretary, Department of Defence, Mr. F. Chilton; and the Secretary to the Prime Minister's Department, Mr. A.S. Brown. ihile in Ottawa, Mr. and Mrs. Menzies will stay at Government House.

This will be Mr. Menzies' fourth visit to Ottawa. His previous visits were in llay 1941 and August 1950 when he was Prime Minister, and in October 1948 when he was the Leader of the Opposition. Mr. Menzies left fustralia on May 14, spent a week in ivashington, left for London on Nay 21 and returned to Vashington on June 17. He will leave Ottawa at $9.30 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$. Thursday, June 26, for New York, and will then fly back to Australia.
