On July 20, 1960 it was announced that His Highness Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra Al-Haj, Prime Minister of the Federation of Malaya, would visit Canada early in November. At his request, the date has been advanced so that he will arrive in Canada on Wednesday, October 19 for a six-day visit.

His schedule is as follows:

Wednesday October 19	12.40 Arrive Dorval Airport: The Tunku and his party will transfer immediately to a waiting Department of Transport 'plane for the flight to Ottawa.
	1.40 Arrive Uplands Airport  (This schedule is dependent on the punctual arrival of the party's trans-Atlantic flight).
Thursday October 20	In Ottawa
Friday October 21	In Ottawa
Saturday October 22	a.m. Departure by 'plane for Arvida.
Sunday October 23	Flight from Arvida to Niagara Falls.
Monday October 24	a.m. Drive from Niagara Falls to Toronto. Day in Toronto.
Tuesday October 25	a.m. Departure from Malton Airport for Washington.

Exact details of Tunku Abdul Rahman's itinerary in Canada will be released for publication on Monday October 17.

While in Ottawa, the Tunku will stay at Government House as the guest of their Excellencies, the Governor-General and Mrs. Vanier.
