The Panel found that Canada's import restrictions on ice cream and yoghurt were not fully consistent with Canada's obligations under Article XI of the GATT. Article XI establishes conditions under which a country may operate import controls in support of domestic supply management programs.

The quota levels for ice cream and yoghurt are being set at 347 tonnes and 332 tonnes respectively for 1990.
