Bill No. 18 to amend the Act incorporating "The Souris and Rocky Mountain Railway Company." (On motion of Mr. Boultbee, the said amendments were taken into consideration, and concurred in.)

The Bill No 75 from the Senate, intituled: "An Act to amend the Petroleum Inspection Act, 1880," as amended in Committee of the Whole was taken into consideration, read a third time, and passed.

The Bill No 77 to amend the Dominion Lands Acts, was read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, amended, reported, the amendments agreed to, and the Bill ordered for a third reading, to morrow.

The Bill No 87 from the Senate, intituled: "An Act respecting Naturalization and Aliens," was considered in Committee of the Whole; and progress having been made and reported,—Committee to sit again, to morrow.

The Bill No 81 with reference to the Andrew Mercer Ontario Reformatory for Females and the Central Prison for the Province of Ontario, was considered in Committee of the Whole, reported, read a third time, and passed.

The House went again into Committee of Supply.
