PROPOSING MEMBERS, &c.

I.

No Brother shall be admitted a Member of this Lodge without a regular proposition in open Lodge, nor until his name, occupation, and place of abode, as well as the name and number of the Lodge of which he is, or was last, a Member, shall have been sent to all the Members in the summons for the next stated Lodge Meeting; at which meeting the Certificate of his former Lodge is to be produced, or other satisfactory testimony of his good conduct; and his name shall stand on the books for one Month, that due enquiry may be made as to character.

II.

No person shall be made a Mason in this Lodge without a regular proposition in one Lodge, and a ballot at the next regular stated meeting, nor until his name, addition, or occupation, and place of abode shall have been sent to all the Members in the summons, and his name stand on the books one Month, that strict enquiry may be made as to his character.

III.

Every person wishing to be made a Masen in this Lodge must be a free man, of the full age of twenty-one years, and his own master, and be known to be in reputable circumstances at the time
