Driven by Don Geers, Napoleon Direct,
in the 2:03 pace, went the first heat in
2:02 1/2 and repeated in the second heat
in 2:03 flat, being a season's pacing
record, as well as the fastest two heats
on record this year for a pacer.

He had nothing on Margaret Druien,
Piloted by Walter Cox, the mare set a
season's trotting record in the 2:05 trot
by stepping the first mile in 2:04 1/2. Re-
turning in the second heat she went
the circuit in 2:05 1/2, giving her the
fastest second heat and two heats in a
race that have been recorded in 1915.
