Hon. CHARLES FITZPATRICK (Minister of Justice). In Kingston penitentiary, there is no change in the salaries of the warden and deputy warden. The deputy matron gets an increase of \$50. The chaplains remain the same. The surgeon, increase \$600.

Mr. R. L. BORDEN. Will my hon. friend state the causes of the increase in each case?

Mr. FITZPATRICK. There is no special cause but an increase all around.

Mr. W. F. MACLEAN. What is the total increase?

Mr. FITZPATRICK. \$9,100 for Kingston penitentiary, distributed over thirty-one officials.

Mr. BERGERON. Why has the warden of St. Vincent de Paul less salary than the Kingston penitentiary?

Mr. FITZPATRICK. That has always been the case. At Kingston, the warden has charge of the insane convicts. All the insane prisoners are sent there. The accountant gets an increase of \$300. Warden's clerk, increase \$100. Storekeeper, \$100 increase. Assistant storekeeper, \$100. Steward and baker, \$100. Assistant steward, \$100. Hospital overseer, no change. Messenger, no change. Engineer, no change. Electrician, \$100. Assistant electrician, \$100. Firemen, an increase of \$100 each for three.

Mr. BERGERON. Why are some given increases and some not?

Mr. FITZPATRICK. I take the report of the inspectors and abide by it. They have decided that these increases are proper under the circumstances and I have accepted their report.

Mr. BERGERON. There is no injustice to anybody?

Mr. FITZPATRICK. I have not heard a word of complaint. My information is that all the officials are satisfied except the deputy wardens' and under the circumstances I do not see any reason why their salaries should be increased. Superintendent of
