



CAR REPAIRMEN TO BENEFIT MOST BY LATEST AGREEMENT

New Arrangement With Shopmen Stands For One Year.

Montreal, Nov. 14.—The new agreement arrived at between the Canadian Railway Board and representatives of the Shopmen's Union provides that men engaged in locomotive work are to receive an increase of four cents per hour and men in car repair shops an increase of nine cents an hour. The differences in the increases is due to the fact that the repair shopmen claimed that under the old agreement they had not received as liberal treatment as their co-workers. Changes in hours of labor, particularly, affect men in the shops where heavy work is carried on. These men, under the old agreement, worked eight and one-half hours a day five days a week, and four and one-half hours on Saturday, forty-seven in all. Under the new agreement they work a forty-four hour week eight hours for five days and four for Saturday. The hours of the men in the roundhouse remain at eight hours a day, six days a week. The agreement stands for one year from November 1, 1919, but the men will get the new wage terms as from May 1, 1919, when negotiations with the war board began.


"The seals really represent the ounce of prevention. I wish the campaign all success."


