Three Barrie Plays.

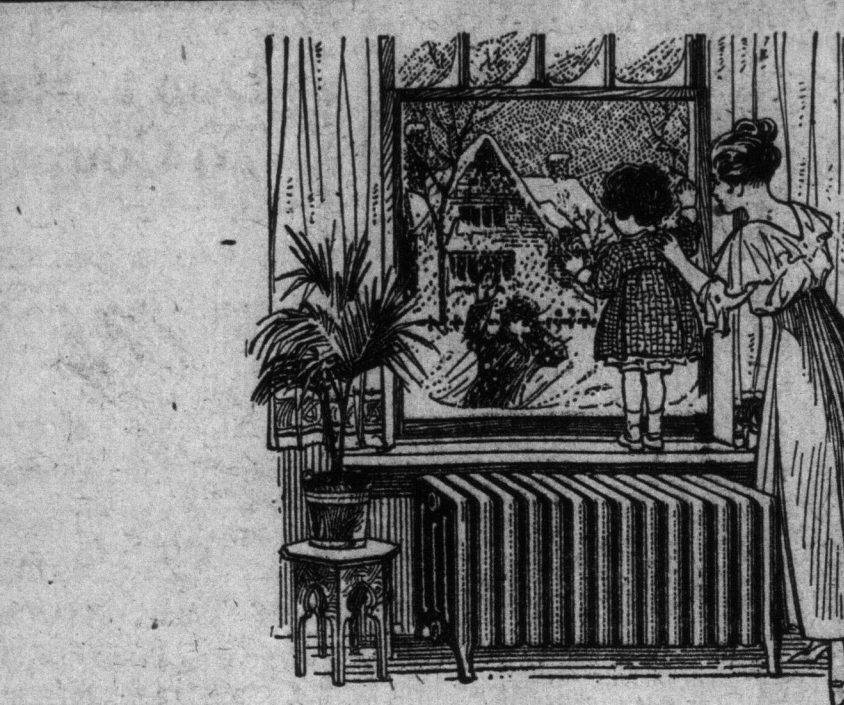
