

NOTES OF THE MONTH.

August is named from Augustus Cæsar. Before his time it was Sextilis, or the sixth month. The Romans dedicated it to Ceres, the goddess of Corn. The sign is Virgo, the Virgin, which the sun enters on the 23rd. The 1st is Lammas Day; the 6th, the Transfiguration of the Lord; the 10th, St. Lawrence's Day; the Assumption of the Virgin; the 24th, St. Bartholomew's; and the 29th, St. John the Baptist's Day. In all ages August has been the month of rejoicing and festivity, as it is the season of harvest, when the husbandmen begin to gather in the fruits of their industry.
