## WIDDER STATION.

Widder Station is a thriving village and station on the G. T. R., 31 miles from Sarnia, 9½ from Forest, and 60 miles from London. It is situated on the 20th Lot and 3rd Concession of the township of Bosanquet. The Post Office was established in 1862; Robert Ray was the first postmaster. The village contains four stores, two hotels, two shoe shops, one bakery, one waggon shop, two carpenter shops, two cabinet shops. The principal business of the place consists in staves, square timber, lumber and grain. It is distant from Widder village one and a-half miles. Daily stages run between both places—fare each way 12½ cents. Population about 150. Mails daily. Thomas Kirkpatrick, Postmaster.

It is the only point vessels can touch between Sarnia and Bayfield.
