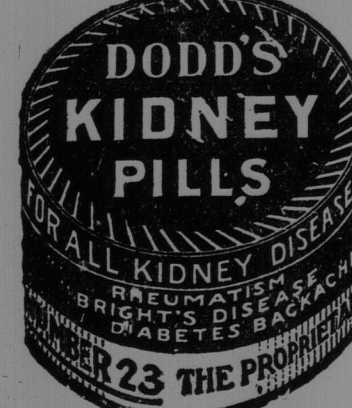

## TORONTO BOARD OF TRADE AND THE GRAND TRUNK

(Toronto Globe, Tuesday.)

Toronto board of trade, by a unanimous standing vote at their general meeting last night, endorsed the policy of the dominion government with regard to the proposed absorption of the Grand Trunk Railway as explained by Hon. J. D. Reid, minister of railways and canals, who presented the case in favor of the measure. The meeting was well attended and representatives, including in its numbers Sir Edward Kemp, J. D. Allan, Col. H. H. Brock and many others. The speaker was applauded at intervals throughout his address and there did not appear to be one person present not in sympathy with his remarks.

**Text of Resolution.**

Following is the text of the resolution moved by Hugh Blain, seconded by W. H. Alderson and adopted by the board:

"Whereas, this meeting has heard and considered the statement of the Hon. Dr. Reid, minister of railways and canals, of the position of the several railway systems of Canada;

"And whereas it is manifest that the present Canadian Government Railway System, owing to its having no feeders, in Ontario and Quebec, must either take
