Success Attends Upon the Work of M. McDade

Reports all indicate that the war stamp organization work is going on well all over the province. Michael McDade is looking after the outside work. The Chatham World of Wednesday said: "An excellent meeting of representative citizens responded to Mr. McDade's call for a meeting to consider the forming of an organization in Chatham for popularizing the sale of the new Canadian government security, the war stamp. Mr. McDade had addressed two or three societies on Sunday, and had had a conference with the Red Cross committee on Monday, and the result of his preliminary work was shown by the attendance."

"F. E. Neale was called to the chair and George Watt appointed secretary of the meeting."

"Mr. McDade made a fine address, beginning with references to the public men of the Miramichi with whom he had been friends in the past, and then presenting the claims of the new loan to consideration in a clear, logical and convincing manner, showing that the government needed the money to pay war claims, and that habits of thrift would be formed, especially among the youth, by popularizing the sale of these prom-
