The Synod appointed their next meeting to be held in St. Andrew's Church, in the City of Toronto, on the Second Wednesday in September, 1847, at Seven o'clock, P. M.

The Moderator then addressed the Synod;—when, after prayer and singing Psalm cxxii. 6—9, the Synod was closed with the Apostolical Benediction.
