News and Views of the Ever Advancing Army of Workers... Under a new agreement the machinists employed by the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis and Omaha Railroad have been granted a wage increase of 10 per cent.

Scotch steel workers have had their wages reduced 5 per cent... Mayor McClellan has sent a note to the General Federation of New York City to the effect that careful attention would be given to the demands of the street cleaners, asking to have the eight-hour law strictly enforced.

The amendments to the Manitoba Factory Act in reference to child labor and other matters, having passed the Legislature, James Sutherland, president of the railway organization, speaking on the question, stated that an active campaign to organize all factory female workers had been commenced, and it was the intention to have a strike in such a shape that a big strike might be called in protest against the measure in July next, when the Dominion exhibition would be on.

In line with the actions of other trade unions of Hamilton, Pa., the Brotherhood of Painters, Decorators and Paper-hangers' Union, No. 209, will ask for an increase of wages, to take effect on April 1. The increase is slight and will likely be granted by the employers.

The Hamilton Trades and Labor Council has received the following from the re-elected committee handed out by Toronto labor leaders. Although Toronto is a larger city and has more leaders and unions, it is said that Hamilton is the best organized city in Canada, and the Trades Council is looked upon as the leader in the movement among central bodies.

Another practical turn is being given to the by-election movement at London, England. An influential reparation committee is being formed, with the co-operation of the Lord Mayor, to replace on firm land the unemployed who have been driven from the towns from country life. Relief operations are being confined at first to the unemployed of East and South London.
