Inquest Resumed This Morning—Testimony of Identification

London, Sept. 12.—The undertaker and morgue-keeper who cared for the decomposed remains found in the basement of the home of Dr. Crippen spent an uneasy half hour to-day under the cross examination of Arthur Newton, who is defending Crippen in his trial for the alleged murder of his wife.

When the post-mortem inquest was called Newton stated that the morgue-keeper and the undertaker were summoned. His object was to secure from them an admission that when they removed the fragments from the basement they used carbolic acid to counteract the odors.
