

## LA VIE CATHOLIQUE

### Le bilan tragique des prêtres tués au Mexique en haine de la foi.

A Purification (Jalisco) vivait un prêtre âgé de 88 ans, don Martin Diaz Covarrubias, vénéré pour sa grande bonté et pour sa vieillesse sereine. Il lui arriva vers la mi-juillet de passer devant un corps de garde. Les soldats lui crièrent : Halte ! mais le vieillard, atteint de surdité, ne les entendit pas et se vit soudain entouré d'un groupe de menaçants. Le malheureux, surpris, déclarait qu'il était un homme pacifique, qu'il ne commettait aucun mal, quand un soldat cria : "Fusillez-le" ; c'est contre ces gens-là que nous avons fait la révolution". Une balle d'acier ouvrit les entrailles du vieillard qui ne tarda pas à expirer.

C'est le journal de M. Alvarez, frère du chef d'état-major de Calles, qui publie le fait. Il ajoute que ce régime odieux de la soldatesque a assez duré.

Mathieu Correa, du diocèse de Zacatecas, fusillé à Durango par ordre du général Eulogio Ortiz pour n'avoir pas voulu trahir le secret de la confession.

Emmanuel Mecado, tué à Aguascalientes par ordre du général Genoveva.

Michel Diaz, curé d'Auñan, pendu à un arbre, dans les premiers jours de février 1927.

Herménégilde Lara, tué à San Ignacio par ordre du général Ferreira.

Le curé de San Juliano, condamné à mort par le général Camacho.

Vincent Salas, fusillé à Tampico.

X. Ruelas, tué à Durango.

Secondino Sanchez, curé de Coacul, fusillé à Mascota le 24 avril 1927.

Joseph Sanchez, du diocèse de Jalisco, tué par les callistes sur le chemin de Palmitas à Tocolatlan.

Vincent Lopez, curé de Tunan-tingo, fusillé à Mexico par ordre du commandant militaire.

Fernand Escoto, prêtre de Jan de Los Lagos, tué dans les environs de cette localité le 3 mai 1927.

Michel Guizar, tué au début de mai dans le Michoacan pendant qu'il donnait les derniers sacrements à un blessé.

Le curé d'Asientos, condamné à mort par le général Figueroa.

André Sola, fusillé entre les stations de Mira et de Salas par ordre du général Amarillas.

Raphaël Chovel, fusillé à Léon par ordre du général Daniel Sanchez.

Spiridon Ximenez, curé d'Antequila, fusillé le 20 mai 1927.

Félix de la Costaneda, tué à Jerez par ordre du général Ortiz.

Son cadavre fut attaché à un pieu.

Christophe Magallanes, Augustin Sanchez, fusillé le 25 mai où il resta trois jours et trois nuits sans nourriture, exposé aux intempéries ; il ne se plaignait pas ; à la fin, on le lia à une colonne de l'église et on le tua à coups de poignard.

Ajoutons à cette page de martyrologe la mémoire de 16 prêtres tués au début de mai au cimetière Dolores de Mexico et ensevelis, quelques-uns du moins, avant d'avoir rendu le dernier soupir.

On parle aussi de quatre prêtres tués pendant la semaine rouge du début de mai.

La mort de ces prêtres s'accompagne le plus souvent de cruautés et d'outrages. Ce que nous savons suffit à juger l'œuvre du gouvernement socialiste du président Calles. Œuvre de barbarie et de sang qui va rejoindre dans le crime et la misère publique les horreurs de la Russie soviétique.

Et ceux-là qui, en France, protestent le plus violemment contre l'exécution de deux hommes que, sans les connaître, ils déclarent innocents, n'ont qu'admiration pour le tyran de Mexico et mépris pour ces innocentes victimes.
