

FIRST AID VIEWS

Instructive Series of Motion Pictures Shown at Imperial Theatre Yesterday.

A very instructive series of views were shown at the Imperial Theatre yesterday afternoon under the auspices of the St. John Ambulance Association. Lieut.-Col. Birdwhistell, general secretary of the Order of St. John nine hundred years ago and said that the aim of the association was to spread the knowledge of first aid. He spoke of the aid given by the association during the war when it affiliated with the Red Cross to prevent overlapping of effort, and told of the instruction of 200,000 Canadian troops in first aid before their departure overseas. Splendid assistance testified to by all soldiers under their care has been rendered by the 200 young women who went overseas as V. A. D.'s. 70,000 Canadians have taken the courses since 1914.

The lectures are given one a week for six weeks, and a simple text book is published. If any town wants a class they can write to headquarters at Ottawa. The work is now taken up by most provincial governments, and teachers and heads of factories have to be qualified in first aid before gaining certain positions.

The pictures, which were mostly taken in England, were acted by graduates of first aid classes. The views were arranged by Lieut.-Col. Birdwhistell.

Pictures were shown of first aid in cases of a crushed foot, of a sprained ankle, injury to the spine, drowning accidents, fractured jaw, method of carrying casualties demonstrated by a detachment of an ambulance corps, and a scene where a resourceful policeman makes splints, slings and bandages out of materials at hand.

The theatre was well filled with an interested audience.
