




Fredericton, March 17-The following bill providing for the importation of horses and sheep was introduced in legislature Friday by Hon, Mr. Farris. The lieutenant-governor is hereby auth-

The heutenant-governor is hereby alth-orized upon the recommendation of the commissioner of agriculture to purchase for the province such a number of horses and sheep for breeding purposes as he may determine to be in the public inter-est and for that purpose may incur an exceeding to a summit, but exceeding expenditure to an amount not exceeding \$25,000 which amount shall be paid out of

\$20,000 which amount shall be paid out of the revenue of the province. Such horses and sheep shall be resold by the commissioner of agriculture at such time and under such terms and conditions as to their being kept within the province, and other as may be determined by the lieutenant-governor in council. 24
