An Act to amend the Act respecting the division of Lower Canada into Counties, as regards representation in the Legislative Assembly.

John, Napierville and Laprarie, respectively, for the purpose of of representation in the Legislative Assembly, and to amend chapter seventy-five of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada in that 5 behalf: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. For the purpose of representation in the Legislative Assembly, Boundaries of but for no other, the Parish of St. Jacques Le Mineur, now comprised of St. John, for such purpose in the County of Laprairie, shall hereafter be com-Namerville, 10 prised in the County of St. John; the Parish of Lacolle, now com-and Laprairie prised for such purpose in the County of St. John, shall be comprised for representation in the County of Napierville; and the Parish of Et. Rémi, including only, the Village of St. Rémi, now comprised for such purpose in the County of Napierville, shall be comprised in the County of Laprairie; and 15 chapter seventy-five of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada is hereby amended accordingly.
