I reproduce Tables Nos. 1 to 10, with the alterations and additions necessary to adapt them to the date of these Returns. These tables exhibit a very serious decline in the values of imports and exports, and consequently in the aggregate trade of the Dominion, while, owing to the effect of the new tariff, during the three and one-half months of its operation, there appears a slight increase of Customs Revenue over either of the three preceding years.
