WHEREAS the Moderators of the Synods of "the Presbyterian Church Preamble.

of Canada," and "the United Presbyterian Church Preamble. of Canada," and "the United Presbyterian Church of Canada" respectively, by and with the authority of such Synods, have, by their 5 petition, stated, That the Presbyterian Church of Canada and the United Presbyterian Church of Canada have agreed to unite together and to form one body or denomination of Christians under the name of "The Canada Presbyterian Church;" And for the furtherance of this their purpose and to remove any obstructions to said Union which may 10 arise out of the present form and designation of the several trusts or Acts of Incorporation by which the property of the said Churches and of the several Congregations connected with said Churches respectively are held and administered or otherwise, and for the better administration of the said Trusts, the said Petitioners prayed for certain Legislative provisions to be made in reference to the property of the said Churches and other matters affecting the name in view of such Union. Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. As soon as the said Union takes place all property, real or per- Property real powerful real powerful to or hold in trust for or to the use of any Convested in thesonal, now belonging to, or held in trust for, or to the use of any Congregation in connexion or communion with either of the said existing Churches, may thenceforth be held, used, and administered for the benefit of the same Congregation in connexion or communion with the united body, under the name of the Canada Presbyterian Church, or any other name the said Churches may adopt.
