Dear Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 21st ultime with regard to the Indian Reserves in the Province of Ontario where this Department is entitled to a subsidy of 50% from your department on all road work performed, I am returning herewith copies of the proposed agreement, in duplicate, in which are incorporated a list of the reserves on which are located highways which form extensions of or connecting links in county road systems on which work has been performed, according to reports received from our Indian Agents, and which may be verified by your Department.

If the lists submitted meet with your approval I would request you to have the agreement signed and returned here for the signature of the Deputy Superintendent General, after which one copy will be returned to you.

In this connection I would inform you that the Cape Croker Reserve, which has in the past been subject to a subsidy of 80% on road work performed on roads which form extensions of or connecting links in county road systems, has not been included in this agreement. Will you kindly advise me if a special agreement should be prepared to cover the 80% refund for this reserve?
