Dear Sire-

Referring to your letter of the 21st ultime with regard to the Indian Reserves is the Province of Onterio where this Department is entitled to a subsidy of 50% from your department on all read work performed. I as returning herewith copies of the proposed agreement, in deplicate, in which are incorporated a list of the reserves on which are located highways which form betweenders of or connecting links in county read systems on which work has been performed, according to reports received from our Indian Agents, and which may be verified by your Departments.

If the lists submitted mosts with your approval I would request you to have the agreement signed and returned have for the algosture of the Deputy Superintendent General, after which one copy will be returned to you.

In this semmention I would inform you that the Cape Croker Reserve, which has in the past been subject to a subsidy of 805 on road work performed on roads which form extensions of or connecting links in county road systems, has not been included in this agreement. Will you kindly advise me if a special agreement should be propared to cover the 805 refund for this reserve?
