Uplands, Ontario	8-9-42		Overcast. The Commanding Officer was admitted to the Civic Hospital in Ottawa for a minor operation, Wing Commander A.B. Searle taking temporary command of the Station. At 1755 hours at Main Aerodrome, R144343, LAC Christie, B.A., a student pilot in Course 59, ground-looped Harvard aircraft 2597. Aircraft swung and struck Harvard 3113 thirty feet off runway. Harvard 3113 a "C-2" category crash, and 2597 a "C-3". No injuries sustained.		
	9-9-42		Overcast, light rain with fog. Physical Training and Drill for personnel of the Station.		
	10-9-42		Overcast, raining all day. Commanding Officer's Weekly Parade was held at 0745 hours. Physical Training and Drill for personnel of the Station, due to poor flying weather.		
	11-9-42		Clear to partly cloudy. Flying for most of the day.		
	12-9-42		Overcast with showers. Poor flying weather.		
	13-9-42		Partly cloudy. Divine Services were held in the Recreation Hall.		
	14-9-42		Partly cloudy to overcast. At 0330 hours at Main Aerodrome, R108371, LAC Somers, J.H., a student in Course 59, ground-looped Harvard aircraft 3030. A "B" category accident. Serious damage to aircraft. No injuries sustained.		
	15-9-42		Partly cloudy to overcast.		
	16-9-42		Partly cloudy to overcast. Physical Training and Drill for personnel of the Station, due to poor flying weather.		
	17-9-42		Cloudy, ground fog - overcast in afternoon. Commanding Officer's Weekly Parade was held at 0745 hours on the Parade Square.		
18-9-42		Partly cloudy to overcast - ground fog in morning. At approximately 1400 hours, in the vicinity of the Madawaska River near Lake Calabogie, Ontario. R137101, LAC Cross, R.M. and R125936, LAC Ault, A.W., students in Course 57, crashed in Harvard 3828, while carrying out cross-country navigation exercise. Both pilots instantly killed. Command Investigating Officer appointed. Cause obscure.
