leaving will make enquiries with a view to seeing if anything can be done. If no chance effers this week I will take the matter up on my return.

As to the destruction of birds and eggs, it seems to me that this matter comes more properly within the jurisdiction of the Provincial Government. If you have not already written the authorities at Quebec, I would suggest your doing so, though here again it would be well to wait until after the election which I believe is fixed for some time in June.

I need hardly add that it will always be a pleasure to me to assist the Mission in any way in my power.
