



Ottawa, 3rd February, 1905.

Reverend Sir :-

I beg to inform you that Dr. J. F. McAulay who has held the position of Medical Attendant on the Indians of Malagawatch having removed from the vicinity of the Reserve, it has been decided to appoint Dr. H. N. McDonald in his place at a salary of \$75.00 per annum, the amount allowed Dr. McAulay, and Dr. McDonald has been notified to this effect. He is expected to enter upon his duties at once and you will be good enough to requisition for his salary at the end of each quarter at the rate of \$150.00 per annum instead of \$75.00, which has heretofore been allowed him as Medical Attendant on the Whyccomagh Indians.
