Under be the heading "Died or killed" you have shown a loss of 17 head coo of cattle. The return also shows 46 head as sold.

The Department desires that you will submit exti planations with regard to the cattle referred to under the na different headings.

Your return of the Agency stock shows that & oxen were transferred to 68 Muscowequan's Band, while only 2 are \$0 th shown as received. This matter should be explained. The who receipt side of the Pishing Lake return shows 70 head of cattle were raised while the issue side shows only 60 heats The discrepancy should be explained.
