
Ottawa, August 25, 1914.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, in regard to the question of renewal of lease for Crab Island in the River St. Lawrence, which lease will expire on the 1st of September, 1915.

In connection with the above, I beg to say that, before the Department would be in a position to consider the question of extension of this lease, it would be necessary for you to furnish an agreement, providing for same, signed by the Indian locatee, Lewis Angus.
