This dinner - one of a number planned as a means of saying farewell to His Excellency and Her Royal Highness - is intended specially as a means of enabling the members of the Government of Canada (and myself) to bid "au revoir" to two distinguished and very staunch friends of Canada

Perhaps not easy to recall that more than 5 years have gone by since His Excellency was sworn in as Governor General - at Ottawa - on June 21, 1940.

That event, at a moment when the impact of war in Europe was beginning to be felt (Nazi invasion of Norway and Denmark, Nazi penetration into Belgium and Holland Military collapse of France)
