With further reference to the acquisition by the Province of a roadway through Malahat Indian reserve No. 11 leading to the new ferry, I have to advise you that the Department is in receipt of plans from the Department of Public Works which show that the wharf to be constructed in connection with this ferry will occupy a frontage of 90 feet, 40 ft. of this extends southerly from the South boundary of the roadway.

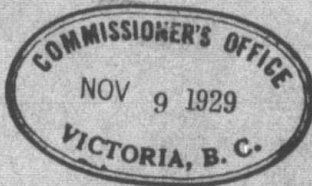
Kindly inform the Department if the valuation in your letter of the 26th September last takes into consideration the forfeiture of the foreshore rights in front of 40 feet of shore line, as well as those which would be forfeited by the sale to the Province of the land required for the road allowance. If not, please advise what additional amount should be demanded as compensation for foreshore rights in front of this additional 40 feet.
