Any person or persons guilty of an infraction of the provisions of Sec. 25 of this By-law, shall forfeit and pay to the City of Toronto for Water Works purposes the sum of one hundred dollars, and also a further sum of five dollars for each day the same shall remain and continue; which said sum, together with costs of suit in that behalf, may be recovered by civil action in any Court of law in the Province having civil jurisdiction to that amount.
