ARTICLE III.

MEMBERSHIP.

Any person whose moral, social, and intellectual tanding is proof that he or she will further the objects of the club and preserve the necessary unity of opinion with regard to them as expressed in ART. 11, shall be ligible for membership.

ARTICLE IV.

OFFICERS.

The Officers of the club shall be a President, three Vice-Presidents, Recording and Financial Secretaries, a Treasurer, a Librarian and seven Directors, who together shall form a general committee of management. The officers shall be elected by ballot annually and shall hold office for one year or until such time as their successors shall have been elected.

ARTICLE V.

MEETINGS.

The club shall meet weekly at their rooms for the promotion of its objects. The first meeting in each month shall be devoted to the transaction of all regular business. Extraordinary or urgent business may be
