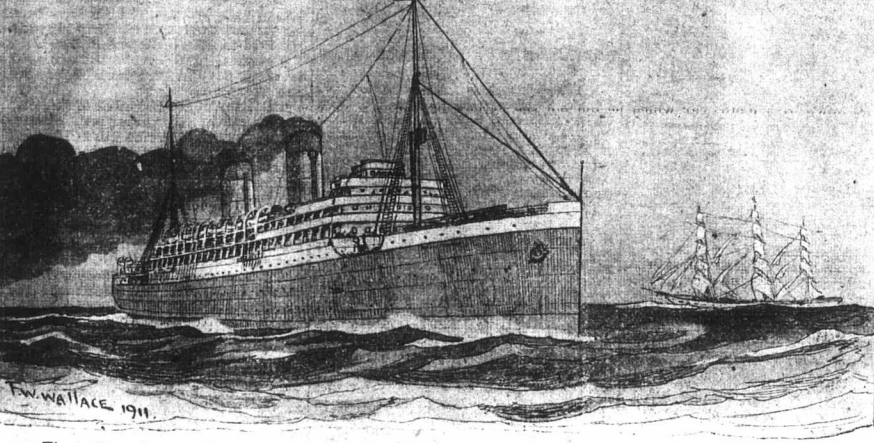

GOVERNMENT TO HELP

Fires Still Raging in Laurentian Mountains in Danger - More Inspectors Needed.

That the forest fires which are present raging in the Laurier Mountains in other parts of the province, and which are destroying large tracts of timber land, as a threatening towns, are caused by the negligence of settlers burning brush about their premises is generally conceded.

A meeting of the various clubs and associations interested in the preservation of the forests in the north-western section of Quebec is being held next week - Thursday evening - at the Hotel Bellevue. The question to be taken under consideration is the formation of a provincial forest conservation commission to measure to stop the forest fires devastating the north.
