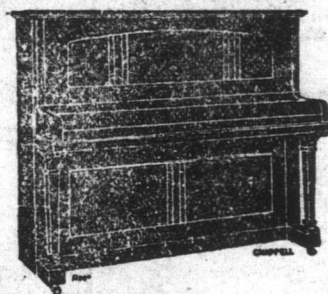

Codfish and Beaver.

A Gazette Extraordinary published on Thursday, contains the following addition to the Act to Regulate the Exportation of Codfish:—

"Section 2—No License Holder shall ship any codfish known as Labrador to the United States of America unless the same shall have been sold outright before shipment, at the prices set forth in the schedule of prices in respect of New York."

Section 8 (Close Season) of the Beaver Act, 1920, is cancelled and the following substituted therefor:

"No person shall hunt, kill, trap, pursue or take Beavers in any area in which killing, trapping, hunting, pursuing or taking is lawful at any time between the 16th day of March in any year and the last day of February in the succeeding year, both days inclusive."
