# PASSENGER TRAIN IS

Narrow Margin.

ST. JOHN, N.B., Dec. 28.—The passenger train which arrived here on Friday afternoon from Boston had a thrilling escape from being thrown from the rails by a runaway locomotive on the Main Central Railway, at Water-ville, Maine.
