TROOPS SHOOT LISBON RIOTERS

Excited Republicans Storm the Church Where Polling Took Place

DRIVE GUARDS TO SHELTER Seven of Mob Killed and Over a Hundred Wounded By Soldiers

Lisbon, April 6.—Seven persons were shot to death and a hundred others were wounded by soldiers last evening after the voting in the elections in this city had ended. The rioting was widespread, and such was the confusion arising in the violent conflict between the populace and the municipal guardsmen...

The principal rioting was the result of a dispute that arose between the Republicans and the Messianists regarding the counting of votes. The Republicans, who had been fearing fraud at the various Lisbon polling places, made a determined stand for their rights at St. Dominic's...

The differences between the officials spread to the crowds that filled the church, and in a moment the rioting broke out and a general fight followed. Suddenly the municipal guards arrived and cleared the edifice of the struggling combatants...

The rioters, whose numbers steadily increased, armed themselves with stones and soon the edifice was surrounded and besieged by a mad mob...

Then three companies of infantry and a troop of cavalry with one battery appeared, driving all before them. By this time night had fallen, and there ensued in the darkness a desperate and uncertain hand-to-hand encounter between the soldiers and rioters...

As the soldiers reached the square fronting the church the guards on the balcony fired directly into the ranks of the infantry men, and three of the latter fell mortally wounded.

Before the charging infantry and cavalry, the crowd slowly fell back. Eventually the mob were dispersed. Seven persons were found to be slain, and the wounded were strewn everywhere...

Smaller manifestations occurred in other sections of the city. Lisbon remains practically an armed camp. Many have been arrested. The people are in a state of feverish unrest, and it is feared that there may be a recurrence of bloodshed.

The cavalry and a large force of police continue to control the streets. There were further disorders today when voting was resumed in the St. Dominic section, where it was suspended yesterday by reason of the riot.

It now appears that four Republicans have been elected in Lisbon. Braga, Almeida, Manzes and Almeida de Castro.

A government note issued today states that "the government gave special orders to secure liberty of voting and the free development of the electoral process."
