TORONTO MARKETS.

Toronto, August 22.—Receipts at City Market to-day—119 cars, with 1,700 head of cattle, 1,750 sheep and lambs, 500 hogs, and 215 calves.

Trade was very active and market firm at 50 to 60 advance over yesterday.

The demand for this class of heavy butcher is very active at the present time, as besides the requirements for the city trade, buyers for outside points devote their attention chiefly to the heavier stock.

The heavy cattle were selling strong to-day at \$5.25, and a few extra choice at \$5.30; good medium choice butchers firm at \$5.50 to \$5.60, and common to medium at \$4.50 to \$5.50; good fat cows, \$4.60 to \$5; medium cows, \$4 to \$4.40; mixed light, \$3.25 to \$3.60; bulls, \$3 to \$5; canners, \$1.50 to \$2.50.

Stocks and feeders are in slow demand, and generally easy at \$4 to \$4.50, though an extra choice load of feeders, 950 to 1,000 lbs., sold to-day at \$5.10.

Good milk cows and springers are firm and in good demand at from \$45 up to as high as \$70 to \$80 for something like extra choice; good springers from \$45 to \$65.

Sheep—Heavy ewes continue very weak at \$2.50 to \$3.25; light ewes dull at \$3.50 to \$4.25.

Lambs easier and dull, at \$5.75 to \$6.65.

Hogs—Market firm and not higher, at \$8.10 fed and watered, and \$7.70 to \$7.80 f. o. b.

Calves firmer, at \$4 to \$7.50.

East Buffalo, N.Y., August 22.—Cattle—Receipts, 125 head; active and steady.

Veals—Receipts, 250 head; active and steady, at \$5.50 to \$6.25.

Hogs—Receipts, 1,500 head; slow; porkers 5c higher; heavies, 10c lower; others steady; heavy, \$8 to \$8.15; mixed, \$8.15 to \$8.30; Yorkers, \$8.15 to \$8.25; pigs, \$8 to \$8.10; roughs, \$7 to \$7.15; stags, \$5 to \$6; dairies, \$7.75 to \$8.25.

Sheep and lambs—Receipts, 1,400 head; slow, steady and unchanged.
