The Maricheets, mentioned in the faid letter form a distinct nation, chiefly fettled at St. John's, and are often confounded with the Abenaquis, so as to pass for one nation with them, though there is certainly fome distinction. used, till lately, to be in a constant state of hostility with the Mickma-But, however, these nationsmay be at peace or variance with one another, in one point they agree, which is a thorough enmity. to the English, cultivated, with great application by the missionaries, who add to the scandal of a conduct fo contrary to their profession, the baseness of denying or evading the charge by the most pitiful equivocations. It is with the words peace, charity, and univerfal benevolence, for ever in their mouths, that these incendiaries, by instigations
