

BOILED CABBAGE.—Have plenty of salted, boiling water, in which a tea-spoonful of soda has been dissolved, plunge the cabbage in, top downward, leave it uncovered and let it boil until tender, that will be, as given in the time table, from twenty minutes to half an hour. Take it out into a colander, drain well, put into a hot dish, put in bits of butter, some salt and pepper, and serve at once. It will be as delicate as cauliflower; the colour will be retained and there will not be an unpleasant odour over the house, such as is always associated with boiling cabbage.


